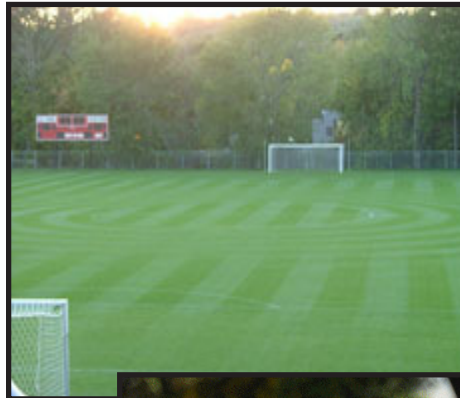

Soccer Excellence Clinics at Clark University High School Week

Joe Brady - Director

Coach Brady finished his eighth year as Head Coach of the Clark University women's soccer team in 2008. Within the past six years, he has rebuilt the women's soccer program after it lost close to 20 senior players over a two-year period (1999 and 2000). Joining Clark in 2001, Brady transformed the Cougars' 3-14 record in 2002 into a winning 9-8-1 in 2004 and 12-8-1 in 2005—a record best since 1999. Brady directed his squad to the semifinals and just missed reaching the finals after losing in penalty kicks to Smith College in 2004 and fell to eventual NEWMAC Champion Springfield college in the 2005 NEWAMC Semifinals. He guided the 2005 team to the ECAC Tournament and reached the finals for the first time in the history of the program. The Cougars fell to Keene State 2-1 in the championship game.

Brady brings 13 years of coaching experience to the playing field. A graduate of Anna Maria College where he was a four-year goalkeeper and team captain for the AMCATS, Brady served at his alma mater as the head women's soccer coach for five years. His coaching prowess led the AMCATS to a 67-31-5 overall record, establishing the team as one of the top programs in the Commonwealth Coast Conference (CCC) and New England region. The AMCATS reached the conference finals three times during his tenure, and Brady received conference coach-of-the-year honors after leading the team to a school-record 17 wins and the CCC Championship in 1997. His 1997 and 1998 teams were selected to the ECAC Tournament.

Brady's credentials also include a National Coaching Diploma from the NSCAA and USSF "C" License. In addition, he was a goalkeeper coach for the Massachusetts State Team, and directed soccer camps for Mount Wachusett Community College (2000-02) and Fuller Hamlets Soccer Club (2002-03). Currently, Brady is a member of the ODP Staff and has coached a number of club teams including the Inter Bandits, 2007 U18 State Cup Runner-up.
