Student Applications

The following table shows Clark University's first-year applications for the number matriculated for the most recent five academic years. The decrease in 2021 was primarily due to the impact of COVID-19. As seen in academic 2020-2021, the number of applications received was a four-year high. With travel returning to more normal patterns, the University is experiencing an increase in campus visits. The University is experiencing a high application volume and graduate admission thus far, with 204 freshman applicants, 65 undergraduate applicants applying to join Clark in the spring. The number of spring applications is higher than the prior year's graduate applicants at this date. In addition, as of early decision for freshman entering in fall 2022 numbered 1,599, 20% ahead of last year's applications.
